## Ordering PPV Is As Easy As 964-PPV8

TriCounty Telecom now offers nine channels of standard definition (SD) and one channel of high definition (HD) Pay-Per-View (PPV). Ordering a PPV movie or event is as easy as dialing 964-PPV8 and following the voice prompts.

Channels 401-403 offer events such as wrestling and boxing, along with other programming, with prices that vary depending on the event. Parents should be aware some of the programming on these channels is not suitable for children. You can place parental locks on these and other channels to protect your family from undesirable content. (See June 2009 *Cable Chat* for instructions on how to set up parental locks.) Channel 410 offers certain event premieres in HD. **Reminder:** You must subscribe to TriCounty's HD/DVR service to receive an HD PPV on channel 410. The automated ordering system will allow you to order a PPV for channel 410 even though you may not have HD capabilities, but the PPV will not play. HD/DVR service requires an HD/DVR receiver which leases for \$9.95 per month. This service provides up to 35 channels of HD depending on your package. HD/DVR service also gives you the capability to pause, rewind and replay live TV as well as record, store and playback your favorite programs and PPVs.

Channels 404-407 offer movies at only \$3.99 per movie. What a deal! Save time and gas—no driving to the video store to pick up and return a movie and no late fees when you forget to return the movie.

There are also two channels of adult PPV programming available, priced at \$8.99 per purchase.

When ordering PPV, you will be asked for the unit ID. Voice prompts will guide you through the process of finding the unit ID using your cable TV receiver remote control. If you have more than one receiver in your home, be sure to enter the unit ID of the receiver on which you want to watch the PPV.

Movies and events can be ordered up to 127 minutes before the start time and up to 15 minutes after the start time. Before confirming your selection, be sure to listen carefully to the name of the movie or event to be certain it is the one you want to purchase. Once the purchase is confirmed, you will be billed automatically for the PPV. Pre-buy PPV by calling our business office at 964-8000 Monday-Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

To find dates, times and channels for PPV offerings, visit [www.goTriCounty.com](http://www.goTriCounty.com), click on InDemand, enter your zip code in the box on the right and choose TriCounty as your provider. You can also use your remote control—press Menu once, highlight the PPV button, press OK and highlight your search preference; or press Menu twice, highlight PPV, press OK and highlight your search preference; or press Guide, select channel 401 and scroll through the listings.

Ordering PPV is simple! Just pick up the phone, dial 964-PPV8 and follow the voice prompts. Then sit back, relax and enjoy the show!

## Feature Presentation

You can search for a program or movie by title. Press the **Menu** button twice. Highlight **Search**, press **OK**. Highlight **A-Z Title Search**, press **OK**.

Using the **arrow up or down** key, select the first letter of the title. Use the **right arrow** key to move to the next letter. Repeat this step for the first 5 letters in the title.

The list of titles will change as you select letters. When you see the title or have filled in all 5 letters, press **OK**. **Arrow down** until you highlight the title you are searching, press **OK**. You will see Info on the show, time and channel. For other dates and times, **right arrow** to highlight the **clock** icon, press **OK**.

In addition to the clock, you will see other options you can select, such as **Buy** if the title is a Pay-Per-View or the **Bell** to set up a Reminder so you won't miss the show.

Rodney Braddy, an Electrical Engineering Technology major at Beaufort County Community College, will fill a summer internship at TriCounty Telecom.

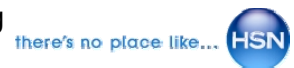

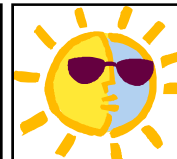
