## High Definition Questions Answered

Most of TriCounty Telecom's High Definition (HD) channels are located in the 700 and 800 number range. Exceptions include channel 410, the HD Pay-Per-View channel, which will only have listings on the guide when there is an event that will be offered in HD; Cinemax HD on channel 301, HBO HD on channel 331, Showtime HD on channel 351 and Starz HD on channel 371.

High Definition channels are viewable only if you have a television capable of receiving HD signals and an HD/DVR receiver leased from TriCounty Telecom connected to that TV. If you do not have these two components but tune your receiver to these channels, you may hear the audio for the programs but will have no picture. Be sure you do not order a Pay-Per-View event on channel 410 if you do not have the capability of receiving HD programming.

Subscribers who have HD capabilities but are not receiving the broadcast networks in HD (channels 702, 707, 708, 709 and 712) should call our business office to have these channels added to your package. There is no charge for these channels, but they must be added to your package for the signal to pass through to your receiver.

## Disconnect Notice Procedures

Disconnect notices are mailed on or about the 17th of each month and the actual disconnect date will be on or around the 24th of each month. If you cannot pay by the date on your notice, **you must call our business office at 964-8000 or 927-8000 or your service(s) are subject to disconnection.**

A disconnect notice will be mailed to all customers who meet the following criteria:

- If your credit rating is "B" and your past due balance is \$19.95 and your total service balance is greater than \$50.00.
- If your credit rating is "D" and your total service balance is \$19.95.
- If your credit rating is "N" and your total service balance is \$19.95.

If your service(s) are disconnected, you will have to pay the applicable charge **per service** plus the total amount you owe on your bill to be reconnected.

**Reminder:** Effective with the April 1, 2009, billing statement, a late fee of \$5.00 will be added to each account not paid in full by the stated due date on your statement. ## Broadcast Digital Transition Delayed Until June 12

The digital broadcast transition has been delayed from February 17, 2009, until June 12, 2009.

On June 12, 2009, TV stations will cease broadcasting in analog and switch to all-digital signals. Analog TV sets not connected to cable, satellite or other pay-TV service (in other words, analog TVs that use an antenna or rabbit ears for over-the-air TV) will need a digital converter box after June 12.

Since TriCounty Telecom has converted to all digital and you have connected our digital receiver to your TV(s), no change is required. It will not be necessary for you to purchase a new TV. Analog-only TVs also should continue to work as before to receive low-power, Class A or translator TV stations and with gaming consoles, VCRs, DVD players and similar products.

The federal government is offering discount coupons for viewers who need to purchase converter boxes for analog TV sets connected to antennas or rabbit ears. **Note: These coupons are for analog TVs connected to antennas/rabbit ears, not TriCounty Telecom Cable TV service.** More information on the DTV transition is available at [www.DTV.gov](http://www.DTV.gov) or by contacting TriCounty Telecom at 252.964.8000 or [www.gotricounty.biz/cabletv-hdtv.htm](http://www.gotricounty.biz/cabletv-hdtv.htm).
