Disconnect Notices No Longer Mailed

Some of you may have received a call in January reminding you of a past due balance on your account. An automated phone call will be generated to all customers who meet the following criteria:

- If your credit rating is "B" and your past due balance is \$19.95 and your total service balance is greater than \$50.00.
- If your credit rating is "D" and your total service balance is \$19.95.
- If your credit rating is "N" and your total service balance is \$19.95.

If your service(s) are disconnected, you will have to pay the applicable charge **per service** plus the total amount you owe on your bill to be reconnected.

Feature Presentation

Your remote control provides a wealth of features to help you navigate through information provided by your set-top box and **i-Guide**. Basic navigation tips include:

- Yellow is always the high-light color. As you navigate listings using your remote, the highlight appears on screen to indicate your current selection.
- Press the up, down, right and left arrow buttons on your remote to move the highlight. Use arrow buttons to highlight guide features, or while watching television, press to begin browsing. Note: Arrows control playback of recorded programs with **DVR**.
- Press **OK** to make your selection.
- Press the **EXIT** button on your remote to return to watching TV.
- The **PPV** button gives you direct access to Pay-Per-View (PPV).
- The + and - **Day** buttons provide listings for the next or previous day.

"Bullrun"—The ultimate test of mind and machine, pitting twelve teams of two people against each other for over 3,000 grueling miles. The XXI Olympic Winter Games

The 21st Winter Olympics will get underway on February 12, 2010. The games will be centered in Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada. The slogan for the international sporting event is "With Glowing Hearts".

Approximately 80 nations with 5,500 athletes and officials will participate in 86 medal events in 15 sports. An estimated 250 athletes will represent Team USA at the Winter Games. NBC paid more than \$2 billion for exclusive United States broadcasting rights to the 2010 Winter Games and 2012 Summer Games. More than 4 billion TV viewers are expected to watch the sporting event which will be held from February 12 - 28.

WITN will present coverage throughout the more than two weeks of Games, with the Opening Ceremony airing February 12 from 9 p.m. - Midnight and the final night coverage on February 28, including the Closing Ceremony, airing from 7:00 p.m. - 10:30 p.m. For additional Games coverage, visit www.goTriCounty.com and click on the Olympics button on the right of your screen.
